Thanks to the launch of the European Horizon 2020 IWM PRAISE Project "Integrated Weed Management: PRACTical Implementation and Solutions for Europe" some fields experimental plots are carried out in order to monitor effectiveness of crop strategies based on cover crops into wheat-based rotations. This open day will also be a good opportunity to visit many others experimental activities taking place in Cà Bosco, knowing their progress and field applicability constraints.
